5. The Halloween Party plans were "brain-stormed", and a majority vote determined that GPMC Treasury Funds will pay for a caterer to provide "finger foods" for the affair. Don & Jaye Wilkinson will host the party at their home, a MAGNANIMOUS and KIND undertaking that was accepted on their part! (We promise to behave).
